

## COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### OSRS WINTER SUMMIT

#### THE COMPETITION

1.1 Welcome to Jagex’s OSRS Winter Summit Competition! We’re giving away a number of prizes in multiple ways to celebrate Old School RuneScape’s Winter Summit! We’ll be giving away prizes before and throughout the Winter Summit!

1.2 The promoter and organiser of this competition is Jagex Limited of 220 Cambridge Science Park, Cambridge, England, CB4 0WA (“**Jagex**”, “**us**,” or “**we**”). These terms and conditions govern the legal relationship between Jagex and you (referred to in these terms and conditions as “**you**”, or “**entrant**”) in relation to the competition.

1.3 Please read these terms and conditions carefully, and in particular clauses 6.2, 10.1 and 10.2 regarding how we will handle your personal data in relation to the competition.

1.4 All information detailed on any of Jagex websites (including but not limited to jagex.com, www.runescape.com and www.oldschool.runescape.com, hereafter referred to as “**Jagex Websites**”), digital platforms, games or apps or published in any of our newsletters in relation to the entry requirements for this competition form part of these terms. In the event of any discrepancy or conflict between that information and these competition terms, the specific competition terms and conditions will prevail.

1.5 Twitch, Facebook, Discord, YouTube and Twitter (or any other social media site) do not endorse or sponsor any competitions hosted by Jagex and we are not affiliated with Facebook or any other social media site in any way.

#### 2 HOW TO ENTER

2.1 There are different ways of entering the competition depending on which social media site you use:

2.1.1 ENTERING ON TWITCH: In order to enter the competition on

Twitch, you must watch the Winter Summit livestream on Twitch on 10 December 2022 and enter the Jagex generated key word that will be announced during the stream.

2.1.2 ENTERING ON DISCORD: In order to enter the competition on Discord, after 3 December 2022 at 11am you must go to the Winter-Summit-Announcements category, and within the #giveaway channel react to the giveaway post.

2.1.3 ENTERING ON TWITTER: There are two ways to enter the competition on Twitter:

2.1.3.1 you must like the post and tag a friend on the “*Seven days of Winter Summit Countdown Post!*” on 3 December 2022 post; or

2.1.3.2 you must like the Twitter post “*Winter Summit post-stream*” and comment with your favourite moment of the stream on the same post.

2.1.4 ENTERING ON FACEBOOK: you must like and comment on the “*Seven Days of Winter Summit Countdown post!*” post on 3 December 2022.

2.1.5 ENTERING ON REDDIT: There are three ways to enter the competition on Reddit. In order to enter the competition on Reddit, you must upvote and comment on one of the three Winter Summit thread as follows (with one winner being picked from each thread):

2.1.5.1 On December 3<sup>rd</sup> on the general

- reannouncement thread titled “[Giveaway] In celebration of our Winter Summit on 10th December, we’re giving away this beautiful Elysian Spirit Shield Neon Light. One random comment will win!” announcing the giveaway and the Winter Summit date;
- 2.1.5.2 on December 10<sup>th</sup>, on the thread “ [Giveaway] We’re getting ready for the Winter Summit in a few hours! Giving away this Slayer Neon Light to another winner in the comments!” with a picture of the lights behind the scenes with J-mods; or
- 2.1.5.3 on December 10<sup>th</sup> on the thread titled “WINTER SUMMIT MEGATHREAD” during the Winter Summit.
- 2.1.6 **ENTERING ON YOUTUBE:** In order to enter the competition on YouTube, you must like and comment on the Winter Summit Reel video posted on 15 December 2022 and subscribe to the Old School RuneScape channel.
- 2.2 As there are multiple ways of winning throughout the summit (before, during and after!), with multiple announcement dates, the competition period will ultimately run from 11:00am GMT on 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2022 to 11:59pm GMT on 20<sup>th</sup> December 2022 inclusive, however please note that on **certain platforms we will announce winners before the 20 December 2022** (each a “Closing Date”) Please see section 5.4 for a breakdown of these dates and times.
- 2.3 All competition entries received by us after a Closing Date (whether or not they were sent before) will be void and will not be entered into this competition.
- 2.4 No purchase is necessary to enter the competition and there is no charge to register for use of a Jagex Website.
- 2.5 Jagex will not accept:
- 2.5.1 responsibility for competition entries that are lost, mislaid, damaged, or delayed in transit, regardless of cause, including, for example, as a result of any postal failure, equipment failure, technical malfunction, systems, satellite, network, server, computer hardware or software failure of any kind; or
- 2.5.2 proof of posting or transmission as proof of receipt of entry to the competition.
- 2.6 There is a limit of one entry to the competition per person. Entries on behalf of another person will not be accepted and joint submissions are not allowed.
- 2.7 By submitting your entry, you confirm that you have read and understood these terms and conditions and agree to be bound by them.

- 3 **THE PRIZE – OLD SCHOOL RUNESCAPE KAMELNEON NEON LIGHT**
- 3.1 The prizes are Old School RuneScape branded Kamelneon neon lights and 12 are available to be won: as follows
- 3.1.1 3 neon lights are available to be won on Twitch;
- 3.1.2 1 neon light is available to be won on Facebook;
- 3.1.3 3 neon lights are available to be won on Twitter;
- 3.1.4 1 neon light is available to be won on Discord;

- 3.1.5 3 neon lights are available to be won on Reddit; and
- 3.1.6 1 neon light is available to be won on YouTube.
- 3.2 The prize is supplied by Kamelneon, Rafał Żurkowski AT ul. ks. Ludwika Tunkla 137, 41-707 Ruda Śląska (the “**Supplier**”).
- 3.3 Prizes are subject to availability. We reserve the right, including where required to by circumstances beyond our control, to substitute the prize with a cash alternative to the value of £80, or to substitute the prize with a reasonably equivalent prize or one of greater value.
- 3.4 The winner is responsible for any costs or expenses involved in claiming or using the prize other than those that are expressly stated above as being included as part of the prize.
- 3.5 The prize may be subject to additional terms and conditions imposed by the Supplier or other organisation connected to this competition.
- 3.6 The prize is not negotiable or transferable.
- 3.7 The prize is for the named winners only and cannot be given or transferred to any other person.
- 4 ELIGIBILITY**
- 4.1 To enter this competition, you must be a legal resident in: (a) all states within Australia, and/or New Zealand, as well as throughout Hong Kong and/or Singapore; (b) all countries within Europe except Northern Ireland and Italy; (c) the following: states within the USA: Alabama; Alaska; Arizona; Arkansas; California; Colorado; Connecticut; Delaware; Florida; Georgia; Hawaii; Idaho; Indiana; Illinois; Iowa; Kansas; Kentucky; Louisiana; Maine; Maryland; Massachusetts; Michigan; Mississippi; Missouri; Minnesota; Montana; New Hampshire; New Jersey; New Mexico; New York; North Carolina; Oregon; Oklahoma; Pennsylvania; Nebraska; Nevada; North Dakota; Ohio; Rhode Island; South Carolina; South Dakota; Tennessee; Texas; Utah; Vermont; Virginia; West Virginia; Washington; Wisconsin; Wyoming; (d) the following provinces within Canada: Alberta, British Columbia; Manitoba; Ontario; Newfoundland and Labrador; New Brunswick; Northwest Territories; Nova Scotia; Nunavut; Saskatchewan; Yukon and Prince Edward Island; and (e) the following countries in Latin America: Argentina, Chile, Paraguay, Peru, Uruguay, Mexico, Colombia, Brazil (these regions together the “**Competition Jurisdiction**”) and be aged 18 years or over at the time of entry.
- 4.2 The following persons are not eligible to enter:
- 4.2.1 our employees or workers, or the employees or workers of any our holding or subsidiary companies;
- 4.2.2 employees or workers of any organisation involved in the operation or administration of this competition including prize suppliers and advertising agencies; or
- 4.2.3 members of the immediate families or households of paragraphs 4.2.1 and 4.2.2 above.
- 4.3 If you are based outside of the Competition Jurisdiction, or your jurisdiction has legal or regulatory rules that invalidate these terms or make Jagex’s performance of them impossible, Jagex will not accept your competition entry and you will be deemed to have been automatically disqualified from it.
- 4.4 In entering the competition, you confirm that you are eligible to do so and eligible to claim any prize you may win.
- 4.5 We may ask for proof of age, residence, or eligibility. Delay or failure to provide the evidence to our reasonable satisfaction may result in an entry being void or a prize being forfeited.
- 4.6 Our decision as to whether an entrant (or their entry) is eligible for this competition is final and we are not obliged to provide any reasons for disqualification.
- 4.7 Entries will be void if they are:
- 4.7.1 automatically generated by a computer;

- 4.7.2 completed by third parties or in bulk;
  - 4.7.3 illegible, have been altered, reconstructed, forged or tampered with;
  - 4.7.4 photocopies and not originals;
  - 4.7.5 incomplete; or
  - 4.7.6 do not comply with these terms and conditions.
- 4.8 There is a limit of one entry to the competition per person. Entries on behalf of another person will not be accepted and joint submissions are not allowed.
- 4.9 Jagex reserves all rights to disqualify you if your conduct is contrary to the spirit or intention of the prize competition.
- 4.10 Competition entries cannot be returned.
- 5 SELECTION OF WINNER**
- 5.1 There will be 11 winners.
- 5.2 All valid competition entries received by Jagex before the Closing Date will be eligible for the prize draw process, with each social media site having a separate prize draw of eligible entrants (each a "**Prize Draw Pool**").
- 5.3 No fee is required to enter a Prize Draw Pool.
- 5.4 Within 7 days following the Closing Date (unless specified by Jagex below), Jagex will select the winners using randomised selection generator as follows:
- 5.4.1 Twitch: 3 winners from the Twitch Prize Draw Pool will be randomly selected using NightBot during the stream on 10 December 2022;
  - 5.4.2 Facebook: 1 winner from the Facebook Prize Draw Pool will be selected using NightBot, winner to be announced on 9 December 2022;
  - 5.4.3 Twitter: 2 winners will be selected as follows:
    - 5.4.3.1 the winner from the post '*Seven days of Winter Summit Countdown Post!*' will receive 2 neon signs (see clause 6.5 in respect of onward transmission of the second neon sign) Prize Draw Pool will be selected using <https://commentpicker.com/twitter.php>, on 9 December 2022; and
    - 5.4.3.2 the winner from the post '*Winter Summit post-stream*' Prize Draw Pool, will receive 1 neon sign on 20 December 2022.
- 5.4.4 Discord: 1 winner from the Discord Prize Draw Pool will be selected using Gnomechild Bot on 9 December 2022;
- 5.4.5 Reddit: 3 winners from each Reddit Prize Draw Pool (with each thread as set out at clause 2.1.5 being a separate Prize Draw Pool) will be selected using <https://commentpicker.com/reddit.php#options> on the following date;
- 5.4.5.1 "[Giveaway] In celebration of our Winter Summit on 10th December, we're giving away this beautiful Elysian Spirit Shield Neon Light. One random comment will win!" on 9 December 2022;
  - 5.4.5.2 [Giveaway] We're getting ready for the Winter Summit in a few hours! Giving away this Slayer Neon Light to another winner in the comments!" on 10

- December 2022 at 8pm; and
- 5.4.5.3 “WINTER SUMMIT MEGATHREAD” on 10 December 2022 at midnight.
- 5.4.6 YouTube: 1 winner from the YouTube Prize Draw Pool will be selected using <https://commentpicker.com/reddit.php#options> on 20 December 2022.
- 5.5 Details verifying the randomised selection from the Prize Draw Pool will be provided in accordance with the winner details in clause 5.
- 6 CONTACTING THE WINNERS**
- 6.1 We will notify the winners as soon as practicable after the Announcement Date using the contact details provided in the entry. Jagex will not amend any contact information once the competition entry form has been submitted.
- 6.2 Jagex must either publish or make available information that indicates that a valid award took place. To comply with this obligation Jagex will publish the RSN major prize winners on a Jagex Website on 10th December 2022 (“**Announcement Date**”).
- 6.3 Reasonable efforts will be made to make contact over a period of 4 weeks of the Announcement Date. If it has not been possible to contact the winner in that time, the prize will be forfeited and awarded to the next eligible entrant.
- 6.4 Once contacted, the entrant must provide their name and postal address through the platform which they entered the competition in order to be sent the prize.
- 6.5 In respect of the winner of the Twitter Prize Draw Pool, we will send both prizes to you, and you will be responsible for arranging onward transmission of the second neon sign to your friend, unless they contact us within 7 calendar days of us contacting you at [competitions@jagex.com](mailto:competitions@jagex.com), confirming their postal address and providing their consent to us and our Supplier using this information solely for the purpose of delivering the second prize.

- 7.5 We are not liable for any damage or loss to a prize caused by a third party. If a prize is damaged or fails to be delivered, we have no obligation to provide a replacement prize.
- 8 LIMITATION OF LIABILITY**
- 8.1 Insofar as is permitted by law, Jagex, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the winner or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the prize except where it is caused by the negligence of Jagex, its agents or distributors or that of their employees. Your statutory rights are not affected.
- 9 OWNERSHIP OF COMPETITION ENTRIES AND INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS**
- 9.1 All competition entries and any accompanying material submitted to Jagex will become the property of Jagex on receipt and will not be returned.
